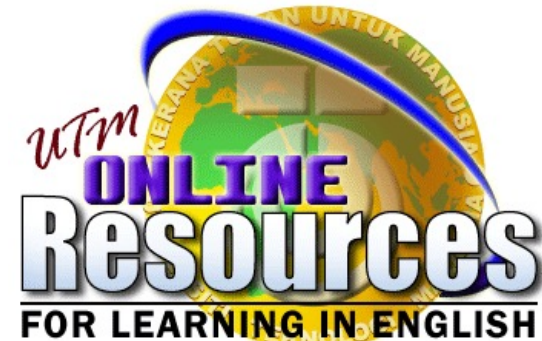

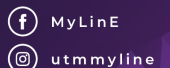



The basic structure of a report usually consists of three major sections: the preliminary sections, the main sections and the supplementary sections.

The preliminary sections include all the information needed in providing an introduction of the assignment. This includes the title page until the page containing the list of abbreviations and symbols.

Meanwhile, the main sections are the heart of the whole report. All your significant information, details, facts and comments are presented in these sections.

Finally, your report should also contains the supplementary sections whereby all references cited in the main sections are included in the reference list or bibliography. Other materials such as pictures, forms and so on could be attached as appendices.

### Vowels in English

A vowel is a sound in spoken language pronounced with an open vocal tract. It is usually represented by the alphabets 'a', 'e', 'i', 'o' and 'u' in the English spelling system. Vowels can be categorised as:

- Short vowels** - Short vowels are vowel sounds that are pronounced in a short form. They are represented by the following symbols in the IPA: /ɪ/, /e/, /æ/, /ɒ/, /ʌ/, /ʊ/, /ə/.
- Long vowels** - Long vowels are vowel sounds which are normally pronounced somewhat longer than the short vowels. They are represented by symbols plus a colon /:/ at the end of the symbol in the IPA. [See the Phonetic Chart for details]
- Diphthongs** - Diphthongs are formed when separate vowels are run together where the speech sound begins with one vowel sound and it moves to another vowel sound within the same syllable. For example, the word "boy". The pronunciation of the vowel consists of two single vowel sounds, /ɔ:/ and /ɪ/ produced one after another within a single syllable.
- Triphthongs** - A triphthong is the production of one vowel sound to another and then to a third, all produced rapidly and without interruption. For example, the word "flower". The pronunciation of the vowels in the word "flower" consists of three single vowel sounds, /a/, /ʊ/ and /ə/ produced one after another within a single syllable.

In its simplest form, Economics studies the allocation of scarce resources in response to unlimited wants. In other words, economics is the study of how people deal with scarcity. ### The Earth's Structure



The earth is a solid sphere. It is made up of three concentric spheres or layers. These are called the core, the mantle and the crust. The solid sphere is surrounded by a gaseous sphere, which is called the atmosphere.

Most of the facts gathered about the Earth are mostly about the outermost layer which is the crust of the Earth. This layer is very thin compared with the diameter of the whole Earth. It is only about 10 km to 70 km thick. It consists of rocks which contains a lot of minerals. These are usually in compounds called oxides, containing oxygen, or sulphides, containing sulphur. The deepest mine in the world is only 3.3km deep, and nobody has ever been able to drill down further than 15km.
